Registration with the Tax Practitioners Board

Noble Accounting Solutions is a registered tax agent regulated by the **Tax Practitioners Board (TPB)** under the *Tax Agent Services Act 2009*.

The TPB is responsible for the registration and regulation of tax agents and BAS agents to ensure they meet required professional and ethical standards. The TPB maintains a public register containing details of all registered tax agents and BAS agents.

Code of Professional Conduct – Rights and Obligations

Registered tax practitioners are required to comply with the **Code of Professional Conduct** under the *Tax Agent Services Act 2009*.

Our obligations include acting lawfully and in the best interests of clients, acting honestly and with integrity, maintaining confidentiality, managing conflicts of interest appropriately, taking reasonable care to ensure compliance with taxation laws, and providing services competently and in a timely manner.

Clients also have obligations under taxation laws, including providing complete and accurate information, keeping required records, providing information on a timely basis, advising of changes that may affect the services provided, and cooperating with reasonable requests.
